Pastor Wendy's Message

What a joy and blessing it is to be at Millville UMC as your pastor. The next step will be to prepare for the reopening of Wesley Hall so that we can again commence the Saturday night praise service. We currently plan to begin that event on July 25. More information will be coming.

In many ways, this reminds me of Noah and his family after the flood was over. Although they had been isolated on the ark with every species of animals as the floods swirled around them, and were undoubtedly anxious to get on dry land again, they took their time to make sure it was safe. After

the rain concluded, the Bible tells us that it was more than seven months before the ark settled on solid ground in the mountains of Ararat, and still more months before the waters had dried up enough for Noah to think it might be time to get off the ark.

Noah then sent a raven to bring back a sign that it was safe to disembark. But the raven, happy to be free, kept flying so Noah then sent out a dove. When the dove returned with an olive branch, they knew that green things were growing. It was not until the dove was sent out again, and did not return, that Noah knew it was safe to consider leaving the ark. And finally, God told Noah it was time to return to the land. (Genesis 8: 1-17)

Likewise, we will be appropriately cautious. But no matter where we are, we can have faith that God is with us. The Lord holds us by the hand and walks this journey with us. So while this is not what any of us would want, we can be comforted in knowing that God is in the midst of these circumstances.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Our Financial Health.... What Is Ahead???

As of the end of June, worship giving was under our 2020 budget estimate by about \$15,000. Our General Fund balance (what we have left after paying our monthly bills) is still holding at about \$37,000. This is due to a conference-mandated two-month relief from pastor pension and health insurance costs, and reducing our expenses, especially utilities.

The reduction in worship giving is especially concerning, given that June 2020 was \$3,000 under May 2020 for the same four-week period. This trend, if it continues through 2020, will result in a significant weakening of our financial health at the end of the year.

We have a number of maintenance and systems improvement projects that we have put on hold for now, but we cannot forego critical maintenance indefinitely. If faced with an emergent issue (ie. roof repair/replacement) our funding alternatives will be limited.

Your church leadership understands that the pandemic, and resulting economic problems, make it difficult for some families to continue to support the church as in times past, but we sincerely appreciate whatever you can do to support the church.

We pray that all will remain safe, and that our wonderful and faithful God will give us the direction we need to sustain our beautiful old church.
