By the third week in April we have completely overcome the worship giving shortfall I mentioned last month. At the end of February, we were down about \$3,900 compared to the budget. As of April 22^{nd} , we have exceeded our budgeted amount by over \$2,500. After discounting the \$2,500 we moved from the general fund to the capital reserve account, we are over our budgeted expenses by around \$1,600.

All that to say, if our 2018 giving trend repeats that of 2017, we will be able to do His work according to His will. Thanks be to God.
