Message From Pastor Brad

Prayer as Clinging

"Then Job replied to the Lord:

- 2 "I know that you can do all things; no purpose of yours can be thwarted.
- 3 You asked, 'Who is this that obscures my plans without knowledge?'
 - Surely I spoke of things I did not understand, things too wonderful for me to know.
- 4 "You said, 'Listen now, and I will speak; I will question you, and you shall answer me.'
- 5 My ears had heard of you but now my eyes have seen you.
- 6 Therefore I despise myself and repent in dust and ashes." (Job 42, NIV)

On the Saturday before our vacation I was asked to share about prayer at the sixth District Revival Prayer Day held in Harrington. I spent some time reflecting on the last several months of my life and I came to realize how much differently I treat prayer now than a year ago. After spending my whole life in the church and the last 12 years in a true relationship with the Lord I thought I knew what prayer is. Having some things laid out before me about myself that had not been named before and beginning to seek healing from them has started me on a different path of prayer.

Intellectually, I knew what prayer was supposed to be and generally how to do it. Spiritually, I always left myself open to what God needed to say or do to or through me in the midst of prayer. Looking back though, I realize I was treating prayer like God topping off the tank of my soul instead of filling the empty and broken vessel I really am. While I spoke at the prayer day, I was holding the district prayer stole that has been draped over our prayer rail in the sanctuary for some time now. I talked about how I and others had held onto the stole while we prayed in church. For me, holding onto the stole is a wonderful image of what prayer is.

When I pray I'm not only talking, or opening up, or trying to dictate the conversation. Prayer is me clinging to God with everything I can, in the same way I can hold onto the stole for all it's worth. Much like Job, I've spent many years with some knowledge, seeing and hearing plenty about the living God and His works in peoples' lives today. Through all of this I'm knocked on my backside and reminded in profound ways that the Lord has plenty of work to do in me yet also. Turns out I have the same shortcomings as Job, what about you? What I may know about any of this I know, but for the big wide rest that I don't, I know that all I can and need to do is cling to God in comfort, faith and trust and let Him lead me through. May we all take every opportunity to do the same.

A Disciple's Path

Our Financial Health: ...We are Continually Blessed

We are still doing well as we enter our last quarter. As of September 23rd, our worship giving is about \$5,600 greater than our budget estimate for 2018, which has dropped a little since our last report. At this time last year, our margin was a little over \$5,000, so we are ahead of our expectations for this year.

The Finance Committee recommended, and the Administrative Council approved, a 2019 budget upper limit of \$170,000, compared to last year's budget of \$155,970. This upper limit is about what we expect for worship giving this year. The budget line item details will be presented for church approval at the Charge Conference on October 6th.

We are so grateful and blessed by the members of our church family who support the effort to reduce the mortgage in ways both financial, and through extraordinary personal effort.

We are still considering ways to have the mortgage paid off by the time the current note comes due in January, 2020, including a "Burn-the-Mortgage" drive. For now, please prayerfully consider a special donation using the pew envelopes.

Special donations towards mortgage reduction by members of our church family are always very much appreciated.

Missions Report..... Meeting Our Vision

We have at various times discussed the importance of Missions in terms of our Vision. The Finance Committee and Administrative Council have taken a positive step in this direction. A new line item was placed in our 2019 budget specifically to support contributions to our sister church, Union Wesley, and to the Salem Food Pantry.

We have committed to a quarterly donation of \$150 to Union Wesley, and \$500 to the food pantry. We currently have \$274 in our Missions account, not enough to cover the next payment. However, the Shoobridge family has very generously agreed to donate \$518, originally specified for Richard's wheelchair, to our Missions account, thereby covering the shortfall.

We continue to encourage donations to Missions through contributions placed in the baskets at the front of the sanctuary during communion, and a jar at the rear of the sanctuary.
