Our Financial Health....

Have (unfailing) Faith

As your church leadership continues to assess our financial situation, it is becoming clear that continued prayer and much soul-searching is needed to get us through this unprecedented pandemic-driven challenge. Worship giving continues to decline as our church family faces uncertainty as to the extent to which they can financially support the church as before.

Although we do have (limited) live Sunday services, gathering restrictions have impacted

giving. At this point, we estimate that at the end of the year, we will be about \$33,000 under our estimated giving income; by reprogramming funds set aside for emergency repairs, we can account for some of the giving shortage. This assumes we can eliminate or defer all but absolutely necessary expenses.

As we continue to have faith that our God will give us the direction we need in order to continue our mission, we need your prayers, and whatever financial assistance you can provide to help us through this time.

Coming in the Fall

Crop Walk - October 18

The 32nd annual Crop Walk in Bethany Beach has been scheduled for Sunday, October 18. This interfaith event raises money to address hunger in our community, and supports the food pantries in Sussex County.

This year, as with all events affected by Covid, the Crop Walk will be different than in the past. Millville UMC has three ways you can be part of the event. First, you can walk at home either around your neighborhood, on your treadmill, or

wherever you feel comfortable and safe. Second, you can swim if swimming is your preferred way to cover territory. And third, you can join other walkers at the church from 1:00 – 3:00 that day (weather permitting) and walk the perimeter of the parking lot.

Sign-up sheets will be available after worship or by calling the church office. We are scheduling walkers in starting intervals so that social distancing can be maintained.

If you would like to sponsor the walkers/swimmers, sign-up sheets will be available for that as well. Contributions to the Crop Walk are tax-deductible. Given the economic and nutritional uncertainty in 2020, your participation in this effort is much appreciated.




